This Friday, September 22, is the first School Spirit Day of the year. "Spirit Day" is held once a month, usually on the fourth Friday of the month. Dates are indicated on the school calendar. On this day, students may dress down for free if they wear "Annunciation" or "Vikings" apparel, or the school colors of blue and white. This does include walkathon shirts from past years, but does not include a shirt with a logo from a professional sport team, a college, or high school, etc. If a student chooses not to wear spirit wear, he/she may wear the regular school uniform. All rules for dress down days apply to spirit days also.

Pizza Friday will return next Friday, September 29 and will take place every Friday we are in school for a full day. Beginning next week, parents may $\log$ in to their FACTS Student Information Account to place an order for their child to receive cheese pizza at lunch time on Friday. Orders must be placed by noon of the Thursday before the Friday pizza is being served.


Pizza can only be ordered through FACTS. It will not be available for purchase on Fridays.

## FACTS Invoices:

Several charges were posted to the FACTS accounts last week. The first fee is the Party Fee. This fee is $\$ 10.00$ per child and is due on October 16. This fee covers the cost of the three classroom parties each year, Halloween, Christmas, and Valentine's Day. The fundraising fee of $\$ 175.00$ per family was also posted. It is due on October 30, 2023. (Families with a child in preschool only are not charged the fee.) Finally, if you have a student playing a sport, the Athletic Fee of $\$ 60.00$ was applied. This fee is due September 25, 2023. Finally, if your child uses extended care, your bill was posted and is due September 25, 2023.
